We are glad you have chosen to enroll your child at All Saints and we want to help you become involved parishioners at St. Peter! By sending your child to Catholic School you are investing in the future faith life of your child. When you re-register for school each year, don't forget to submit your **Family Acknowledgement form** to the parish office to qualify for the reduced Catholic tuition rate.
